The Dance Company, on the other hand, flew to Perm in Russia where they performed and met with a Russian Dance Company to create a combined piece.



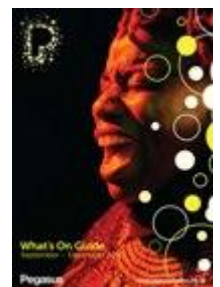
